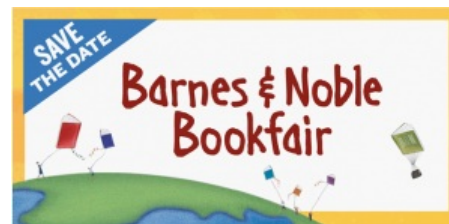
From our office

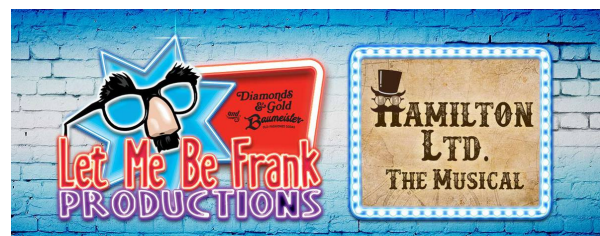
