

MINI TIN CAN DRUMS

DIY PROJECT TUTORIAL

SUPPLIES

HOT GLUE ACRYLIC PAINT

PAINT BRUSH EMPTY CANS

START HERE

BALOONS SCISSORS RIBBON

Pick out a balloon.

Take a tin can and begin by adding your paint. This is where you get creative! **Allow to dry before

next step!

With a scissors, cut your balloon just about where it starts to get big towards the base.

Stretch the balloon over your tin can. You need to stretch it as much as possible to get the best drum sound.

With the hot glue, add your ribbon to the seam of your balloon. This will help glue the balloon in place as well as glue on the ribbon.

Now it's ready for some drum sticks!

> Find some drum sticks and you're ready to make some music! You can use paper tubes. pencils, paint brushes, or anything else you can find!
